The provision of first aiders at work is stipulated by The Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations. The contents of the course comply with Health and Safety Executive requirements and the Textile Centre is an HSE approved centre for this course.

- Resuscitation
- Control of bleeding
- Treatment of shock
- Treatment of unconscious patient
- Dressing and immobilisation of injured parts
- Contents of first-aid boxes and their use
- Transport of sick and injured patients
- Treatment of injuries
- Treatment of burns or scalds
- Simple record keeping
- Poisons and substances capable of causing poisoning
- Personal hygiene in dealing with wounds
- Communication and delegation in an emergency
