

NVQ Level 2 Dry Cleaning Operations

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates employed within the Dry Cleaning environment. It brings all roles within the Dry Cleaning plant into one complete operation; hence ensuring staff are able to fulfil any role within the Dry Cleaning Operation.

Course Outline

The NVQ is made up of 6 work related units, which measure a person's capability and job competency.

There are 5 mandatory units and candidates must also achieve 1 optional unit.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by PAAVQ-SET with the opportunity for a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Course Delivery:	Candidates are assessed in the workplace by qualified assessors. Candidates produce a portfolio of evidence to show knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence can take a variety of formats including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence and case studies.
