

NVQ Level 2 Equivalent Award in Manufacturing Textiles

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates within the various sectors of the Textile Manufacturing Industry. The job role ideally involves some responsibility and team working.

Course Outline

This qualification (NVQ equivalent) is made up of 6 work related units, which measure a person's capability and job competency.

There are 5 mandatory units and candidates must also achieve 1 optional unit.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by ABC Awards worth 12 QCF credits and will have the opportunity to attend a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- Level 3 in Manufacturing Textiles
- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Course Delivery:	Candidates are assessed in the workplace by qualified assessors. Candidates produce a portfolio of evidence to show knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence can take a variety of formats including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence and case studies
