

NVQ Level 2 Warehousing & Storage Operations

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates within a warehousing environment who wish to have their essential competencies recognised by a national qualification.

Course Outline

The NVQ is made up of 8 work related units, which measure a person's capability and job competency. The qualification is individually designed to match the candidate's job role and knowledge and practical skills development is expected.

There are 3 mandatory units and 5 optional units to be completed.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by the City & Guilds with the opportunity for a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- Level 3 in Distribution, Warehousing & Storage Operations
- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management
