

NVQ Level 3 Manufacturing Textiles

Target Audience & Pre-Requisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates within the various sectors of the Textile Manufacturing Industry such as yarn preparation, fabric preparation, production, dyeing and finishing. Specific job roles could include Textile Technician, Dyeing Technician, Weaving Technician and Laboratory Technician.

Course Outline

This qualification is made up of 8 work related units, which measure a person's job competency. There are 4 mandatory units and candidates must also achieve 4 optional units.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by City & Guilds and will have the opportunity to attend a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- Foundation Degree in Textiles
- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Course Delivery:	Candidates are assessed in the workplace by qualified assessors. Candidates produce a portfolio of evidence to show knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence can take a variety of formats including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence and assignments
