

NVQ Level 2 Certificate in Manufacturing Sewn Products

Target Audience & Prerequisites

This qualification is suitable for candidates involved in the creation of sewn products such as sewing machinists, soft furnishers, tailors / dressmakers and clothing cutters. The job role ideally involves some responsibility and team working.

Course Outline

The NVQ is made up of 4 work related units, which measure a person's capability and job competency.

There are 2 mandatory units and candidates must also achieve 2 optional units.

Accreditation & Reward

Following successful completion, candidates will be awarded a certificate approved by ABC Awards with the opportunity for a formal presentation at the Textile Centre of Excellence's awards day. Opportunities for further progression are available and might include:

- Level 3 in Manufacturing Textiles
- ILM Level 3 Award in First Line Management

Course Delivery:	Candidates are assessed in the workplace by qualified assessors. Candidates produce a portfolio of evidence to show knowledge and understanding of the units. Evidence can take a variety of formats including witness statements, observation reports, product evidence and case studies.

Cost:	No cost to eligible learners through Train to Gain £1,078.00 + VAT per candidate without funding
